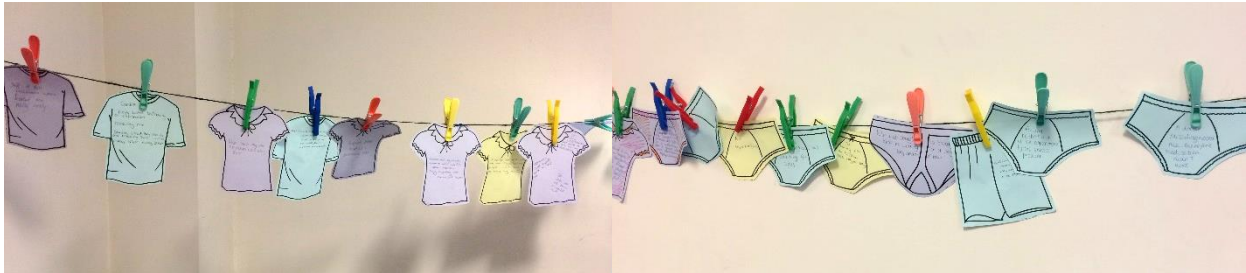


Schools and Colleges

- Icebreaker activity

- Group work - enabling students to discuss and present feedback on topic questions around emotional wellbeing and mental health
- Feedback about individual experiences of health and care services
